

**M. Ed. / Initial Licensure in Second Languages Education  
 Prerequisite Course Evaluation – Greek**

Candidates are required to have an undergraduate degree from an accredited institution with a major in Greek or closely related field, or meet the prerequisites below, and with appropriate liberal arts/general education coursework.

The X’s in the “Course/Number” column reflect outstanding prerequisites. Any in-progress coursework would be counted as complete if an official transcript with proof of enrollment is provided at the time of application.
